From Fr. Shawn - An Update on the Traditional Latin Mass...

The priests who celebrate that Mass met with Bishop Caggiano recently. Two important points came from that meeting. First, the Traditional Latin Mass will not disappear from our Diocese. Second, the locations and how the recent mandates from Rome will be implemented are still under consideration. More guidelines may be announced from Rome within the next two months. Therefore, Bishop Caggiano is waiting for any additional news from Rome before he can make any decisions. The priests will meet with him again on March 2nd, and hopefully, we will have a better understanding of where the Traditional Latin Mass stands in the Diocese going forward.
