

Standards for Fast and Abstinence

(for Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday)

- * Every person 14 years of age or older must abstain from meat (and items made with meat) on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent.
- * Every person (age 18-59) must fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- * Every person 14 years of age or older must abstain from meat (and items made with meat) on all other Fridays of the year, unless he or she substitutes some other form of penance for abstinence.
- * To fast means only one complete meatless meal can be taken on these days. Other smaller meals, if taken at all, cannot equal in quantity to the one meal.


