Eucharistic Miracles Museum: Come visit St. Marguerite's Eucharistic Miracles Museum from Corpus Christi Sunday through the month of August. We celebrate these summer months dedicated to the Sacred Heart (June), Precious Blood (July), and Blessed Sacrament (August) with a display of Eucharistic Miracles organized and explained by Carlo Acustis. By the age of 15, before dying of leukemia, Carlo (now "Blessed") took four years to research and develop and display the descriptions of the miracles around the world to bring people to a deeper appreciation and love of the Real Presence. Carlo had such an intense love of the Eucharist, even at an early age, he would often say "The Eucharist is my highway to heaven." As an amateur computer programmer, he used his skills to develop his website where all the miracles were catalogued and are now on display for you to read. Carlo died in 2006 and was beatified in 2020. The St. Marguerite Eucharistic Miracles Museum is open to visitors every day during our parish hours. "The more Eucharist we receive, the more we will become like Jesus, so that on earth we will have a foretaste of heaven." (Carlo Acutis)


