A Pilgrimage Through and With St. Marguerite

The next time you enter our church you might want to focus on the sacramentals of Saint Marguerite. Sacramentals are objects that help draw us deeper into the life of Christ, the Blessed Mother, and the church.

First, go through the front door, under the

rirst, go through the front door, under the steeple and bell, and walk up to St.

Marguerite's statue. Gaze at it, gaze around it. What do you observe? Clearly you see a nun in habit. What type of nun was she and what kind of habit is she wearing? Why is she both wearing and holding a cross? What is the expression on her face—reserved, shy, determined, courageous? Why is there a lighted dome above her head? If you read the engraved plaque at her feet, you will have some answers, but perhaps not all. Keep these questions in your mind as we continue our pilgrimage to our next image.

It seems to me that we do not pay enough attention to prayer, for unless it arises from the heart which ought to be its center, it is no more than a fruitless dream.

Prayer ought to carry over into our thoughts, our words and our actions.
