It seems to me that we are charcoal ready to be kindled and that Holy Communion is entirely suited to set us on fire. But when this charcoal is kindled only on the surface, as soon as it is set aside, it is extinguished. On the contrary, that which is fired all the way to the centre is not extinguished, but is consumed.

As a final place of repose to contemplate a special and meaningful sacramental of St. Marguerit, please go to the place in church where you normally pray as you prepare for mass, your special pew or chair. One last sacramental remains in the church itself for you to continue to reflect on our Blessed patroness. Embedded in the marble of the altar is a first-class relic of St. Marguerite. A first-class relic is either a piece of bone of the saint, a drop of blood, or a sliver of flesh. Usually, a relic such as this is found in a church named for that saint. It is there to remind us of our patron saint as we celebrate mass in her church. We can reach out directly to our patron saint, here embodied in our church, to intercede with God for our particular intention. Remember our creed, remember we believe "in the communion of saints". St.

Marguerite is our great saint.


