ST. MARGUERITE BOURGEOYS THE CHURCH AND THE SAINT A Pilgrimage Through and With St. Marguerite



Troubled with the message from Mary that she was to go, Marguerite went to her church to pray "A strong impression remained that I should undertake this journey, and I left the church sweetly consoled at the thought that I was indeed accomplishing God's holy will."

How did Sister Marguerite Bourgeoys know to journey to Villa Maria in 1653?
Recruited by the governor of Montreal to found a convent in New France, she sailed to Fort Ville-Marie (now Montreal) that same year. With just two French companions, she began teaching young girls, serving the poor, and welcoming children of the native nations.

Fort Ville-Marie was perilous. Few young women would dare travel there alone, let alone stay to build a school and serve both settlers and native peoples. Yet, inspired by the Blessed Mother in Troyes—and echoing Mary's haste to help her cousin Elizabeth—St. Marguerite held that mystery in her heart and let God work through her.

As Fr. Donald Haggerty wrote in a recent Magnificat meditation: "There can be a sense of urgency in love's awareness... To delay and lose time when love can be exercised right now for a soul in need is to throw away an irrecoverable chance... we often need simply good eyes sensitive to a need for attention in a poor soul." In devastated Ville-Marie, many souls needed that loving care. As if beckoned by Mary, and with the blessing of her confessor and other religious, she sailed—one young woman answering love's call.

The sisters later remembered in The Pearl of Troyes that they had come "animated by the same single-hearted, pure, unselfish love, to make God known to hearts that knew him not." (p. 64; parish archives)
