

ST. MARGUERITE BOURGEOYS THE CHURCH AND THE SAINT A Pilgrimage Through and With St. Marguerite

We find in the reminiscences of Sister Bourgeoys the following story - While settlers were working outside the fields of Ville-Maria gathering crops, the priest, Le Maristre, was saying prayers and guarding them. An Iroquois ambushed him, killed him and beheaded him. This same chief who gave Le Maistre his final blow later converted to Christianity. He gave his daughter, Marie, to Marguerite's care "that she might be instructed in the principles of our holy faith". Later, he carried her to a Frenchman who was employed in the seminary where she worked and later married. This is a stunning example of the dangers that lurked in the colony, and yet the incredible power of the Holy Spirit to work in the hearts of all men.

God's love hath given her nobler being and made her heart a home for all the deep sublimities of heavenly impulses.
